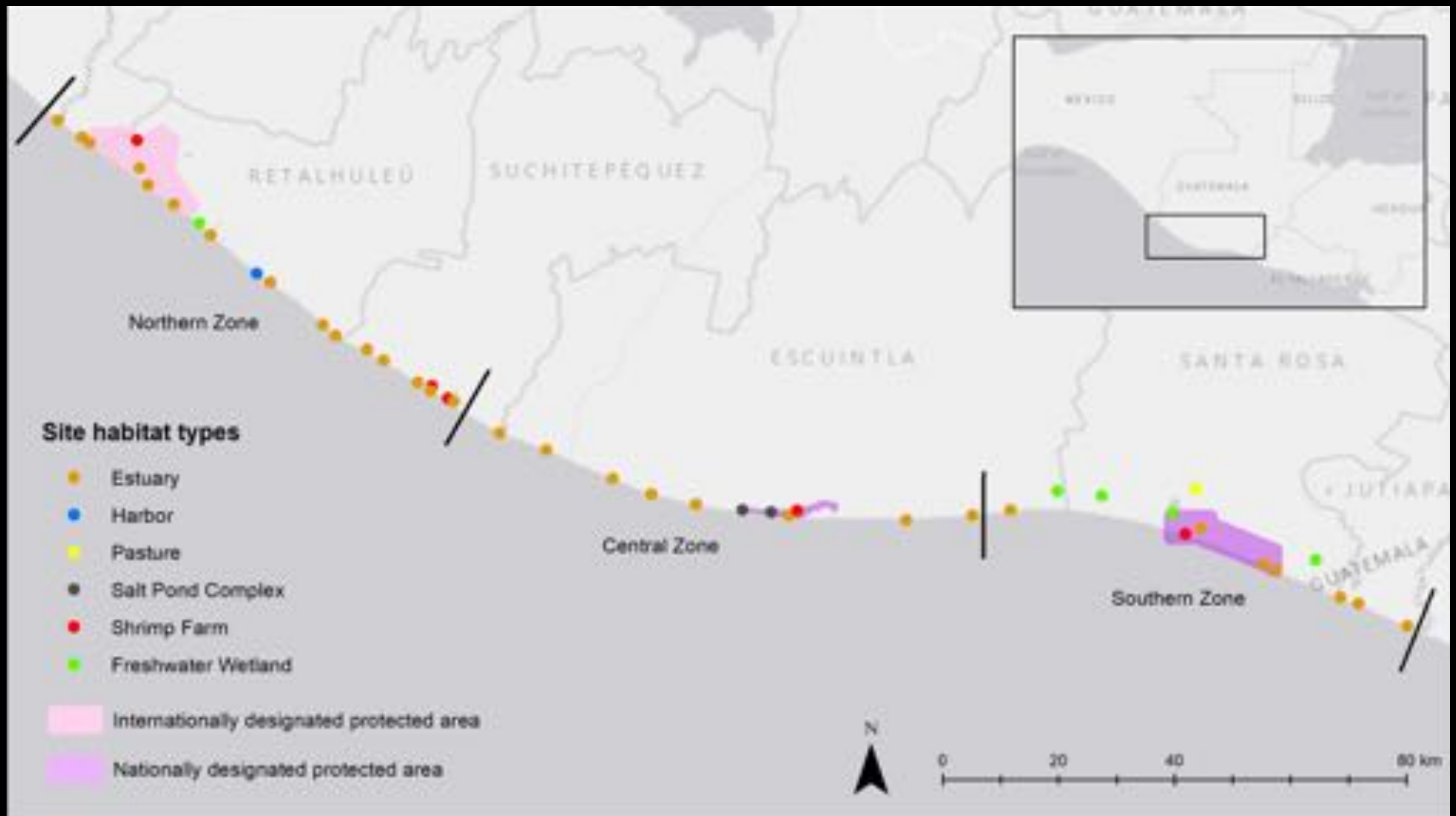

[Suggesting] that additional data gathering, analysis and partnership development will be helpful in determining key shorebird sites in these countries.”







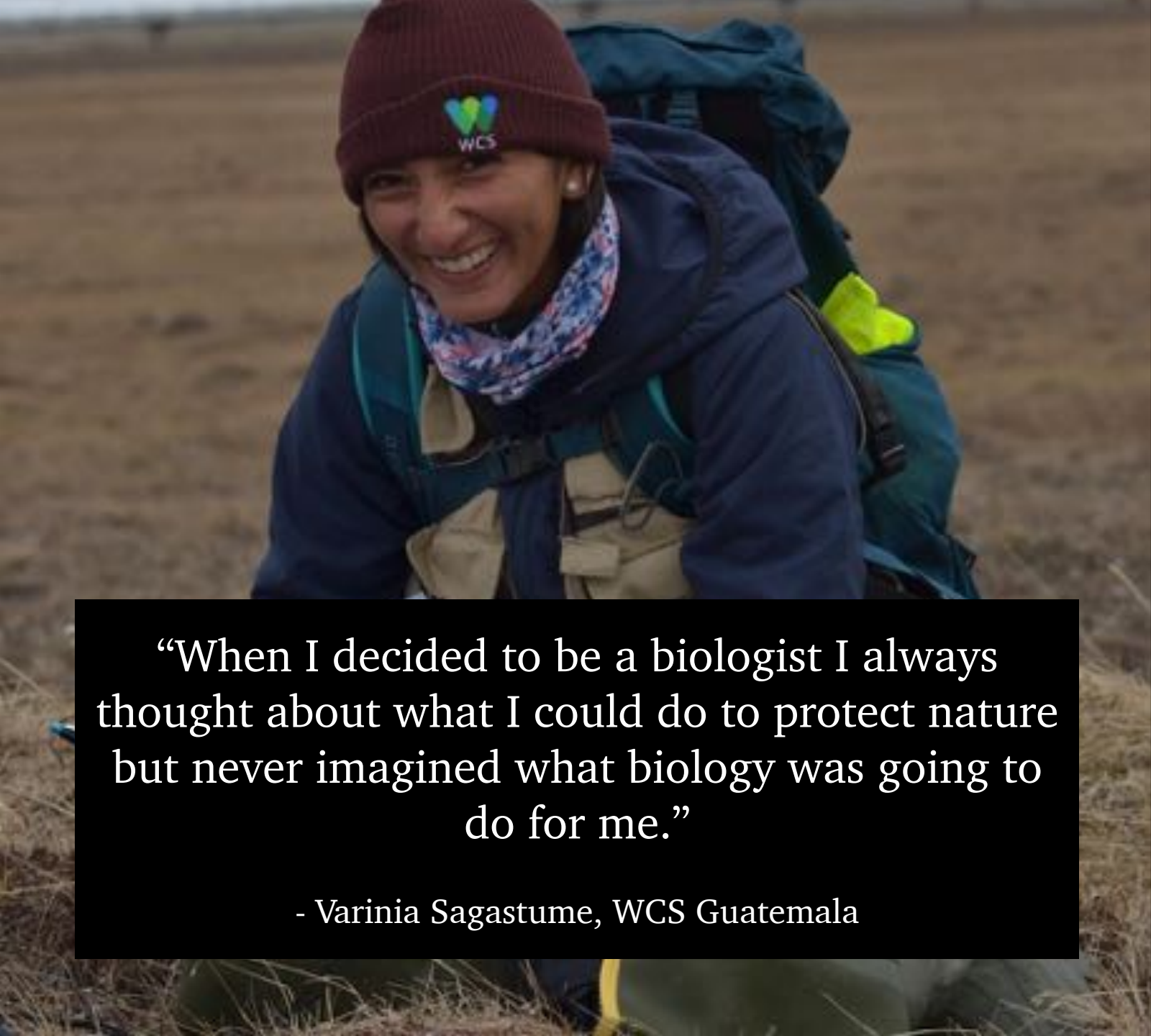


Abundance and distribution of wintering shorebirds along the Pacific coast of Guatemala
